My current role is as a trainee accountant on the audit team. When I am given an audit file, I usually spend about a week with the client, getting as much work done as possible. It's on-the-job training, and it can be very varied.

You really get to know the clients, and it's a great feeling when you pick up the phone and can answer a query from your own knowledge. Of course, there is always guidance and support available from colleagues when you need it, but you really feel that you are making a worthwhile contribution to the client's business.

I'm also a member of the Green Team, helping drive *ifac*'s sustainability agenda Currently, we recently obtained a B Corp certification.

On a typical day, I go to the gym before work and I study in the evenings as my chartered accountancy exams are coming up. I hope to qualify in 2026 and have a keen interest in tax. Our tax team deals with a whole range of businesses, from

We have a sheep and suckler farm, so being local means I work evenings and weekends on the farm. The fact that I can work for an accounting firm that is so highly regarded close to home is fantastic.

The mentorship programme is a fantastic part of the *ifac* graduate programme. Every graduate gets a mentor who works closely to ensure they progress through the programme. Mentors have an open door policy, encourage questions, and promote people to have an open mind about what they're doing.
